An Act relating to child care; creating the Child Care Center Bill of Rights; prohibiting finding of noncompliance if child care center provides documentation of training; providing for codification; and declaring an emergency.

SUBJECT: Child care

BE IT ENACTED BY THE PEOPLE OF THE STATE OF OKLAHOMA:

SECTION 1. NEW LAW A new section of law to be codified in the Oklahoma Statutes as Section 420 of Title 10, unless there is created a duplication in numbering, reads as follows:

The Child Care Center Bill of Rights includes if a child care center or employee provides written documentation of completion of required training, the child care center shall not be found in noncompliance if computer documentation is not updated by the training provider.

SECTION 2. It being immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health and safety, an emergency is hereby declared to exist, by reason whereof this act shall take effect and be in full force from and after its passage and approval.
